Most naturalists are familiar with a wide variety of habitat types, such as a hardwood forest, cedar swamp, or gr assland... but an alvar??

This presentation takes a close look at the ecology of limestone plains (alvars) found scattered around central O ntario. It is a harsh environment, subject to flooding and drought each year; therefore the plants and wildlife that t live here are a hardy and often unique group.

David Hawke has been visiting this habitat since the 1970s. His stories and photographs will reveal the lure an d excitement of exploring alvars.
